--Would this be a closed database or an Open Access database?

--Who administers this database—CADAL or a Task Force?

--How do libraries outside of Zhejiang University communicate with CADAL and send in their contributed contents for the database?

--What are the standards and technical requirements for the database from CADAL's point of view?

### 2. About the contents of the Chiang Kai-shek database:

--The database will include digital images of books, journals, articles only, or it will also include archival materials including photos, reports, pictures, letters, documents?

--The database will include primary source materials only, or it will also include secondary materials?

--Will the database include Chinese materials only, or will it include English, Japanese, and other Western-language materials?

--How do we address the issue of copyright, especially copyright of Western-language books on Chiang Kai-shek?

3. About management and growth of the database:

--Is CADAL responsible for the management and growth of the database with cooperative libraries and organizations outside of Zhejiang University?

--How does CADAL communicate with cooperative libraries and organizations outside of Zhejiang University?

--Should there be an organization in the United States to coordinate the work among participating libraries outside of China? Who?

--Should there be follow-up meetings or conferences for the database following this conference at Zhejiang University?
